**Quarter Tournaments:** On the Saturdays when there is no scheduled sanctioned/doubles tournament or special event, horseshoe players are invited to pitch in a "who comes, will play" tournament. Sign in is at 11:00 AM and some sort of tournament will begin at 12 noon. The pitching fee is \$3.25 per player; of this, \$3.00 goes to the Club for heat and lights. The winner gets all the quarters!

**Use of the Club for Practice:** There is a \$3.00 fee per player for practicing on the pits during hours when the player is not competing in leagues or tournaments.
